## This Registration remains valid until:

- 1. There is a change to the plant such that it no longer complies with the registered design;
- 2. For normally fixed plant, there is a re-location requiring re-commissioning and new measures to control risk as a result of the re-location;
- 3. There is a change of ownership of the plant.

It is the responsibility of the owner to ensure that the plant is inspected and that documents / records are kept in accordance with the requirements of the Occupational Safety and Health Regulations 1996 (see overleaf).

## **INSTRUCTIONS TO OWNER OF PLANT**

## **REQUIREMENTS OF REGULATION 4.20**

- 4.20 Registration numbers and evidence to be displayed
  - (1) A person who, at a workplace, is an employer, the main contractor, a self-employed person, a person having control of the workplace or a person having control of access to the workplace must ensure that an individual item of plant that has been registered as required by this Division is not used at the workplace unless-
    - a. the registration number of the item of plant is legibly stamped on the plant or, if stamping is impractical, is legibly marked on the plant; and
    - b. a copy of the evidence of the registration is displayed on or near the item of plant.

Penalty: \$25 000.
